It is appearing ever more likely that Camden's Temple is a very rare example of a church built for members of a Men and Women's Freemasonry Society, founded by the great political campaigner Annie Besant. The organisation is now titled 'International Order of Freemasonry for Men and Women Le Droit Humane', but known at the time as the International Order of Co-Freemasonry.

To bulldoze this Temple building before it has been properly investigated would be a travesty of justice to the past.
