SECTION ONE: Introduction

INTRODUCTION

This document has been prepared by Applied Landscape Design, it should be read in conjunction with the scheme drawings and other supporting documentation.

EVOLUTION

The planting palette for the scheme has evolved due to a greater understanding of the requirements and knowledge of the roof terrace.

The proposed strategy is to impart a meaning / sense of place that responds to and recognises the building.

The strategy is as follows:

- Create a unique planting palette and style from the rest of the site;
- Create a green carpet to compliment the structure and bed it into the landscape;
- It is to be billowy and light, in a mix arrangement, not block planting of species; and
- Tighter densities to allow for a greater impact upon completion.

DESIGN RESPONSE

As detailed in the subsequent pages the revised strategy for the planting at the roof level is bound by the following guidelines:

- Restriction in the use of colours to greens, purples, yellows and whites so as to no distract;
- Large swathes of plant mixes in single colours to set it apart from the rest of the scheme and assist in the creation of a green carpet;
- Mixture of perennials, semi evergreen perennials and shrubs to provide continuous cover and year round interest.



PLANTING PROPOSALS - reflecting the desired design evolution to move to a more fluid style of planting that is fuller and billowy, less regimented.






