Opening and closing times for this property, where the entrance is inside the Brunswick Centre, would attract an increased footfall at hours where residents are likely to be in a state of rest. The increased footfall, may well comprise of gym goers who commute via bike. The chaining of bikes and other associated mechanical noises would be very distinct around the proposed times of opening. The boxed in nature of the centre reflects noise towards the flats above, and at a time where normal ambient environmental noise is at a minimal, any noise disturbances would be pronounced. Therefore opening times should be limited to a more suitable hour to preserve what little sanctity remains at present, if any. An opening time of no earlier than 8AM should be considered for every day of the week. A closing time of no later than 8PM Monday to Friday should be considered to ensure that customers have good time to vacate the area and the staff are able to do the same therefore reducing the environmental impact to residents from a noise point of view. Proposed closing times for Saturday and Sunday are acceptable. The addition of a juice bar is not needed given the proliferation of healthy eating and other food premises within the centre at present. Such an addition, may eventually lead to external furniture, given the constant noise pollution from other premises that are a disturbance to myself and other residents I have spoken to, this would only lead to more issues. |
