Residential development on Hampstead Heath: 2017/1822/P

The Heath is designated a Site of Metropolitan Importance for Nature Conservation (site reference M072) and is valued for its importance to biodiversity due to a range of habitats, including bogs, wide expanses of grassland and ancient woodland. It is entirely inappropriate that such a site be used for residential development.

Residential development on this site would also cause harm to the Conservation Area and nearby listed buildings.
