Sap, debris, bird mess all over garden - garden not use-able as unhygienic

Blocks significant portion of light such that flat is extremely dark and also affects neighbours

Tree is nowhere near full height and is unsuitable in its location.

We are keen to re-plant With a Silver Birch 12-14 girth which would be a more elegant specemin in keeping with the landscape.
