I confirm that, from a structural point of view, as there are no changes to the basement in this new proposal from that submitted for the previous application (ref: 2015/5847/P) then the information provided for the previous Basement Impact Assessment remains the same and as such was approved as part of that previous application (see attached decision notice);

The addition of a part second floor storey does not have an impact on the basement design as set out in our previous Basement Impact Assessment though it is worth noting that the increased dead load would have a beneficial effect on resisting any uplifts should they be found to be present. The increased loadings caused by the additional part storey will be accommodated as part of the detailed design of the basement.
