1 Reasons for granting permission.

The Council's Sustainability Officer has assessed the submitted energy statement and confirmed that it is sufficient to discharge condition 7. The development is achieving more than a 19% reduction in carbon levels, which exceeds Camden's



policy targets.

The submitted details are therefore in general accordance with policy CS13 of the London Borough of Camden Local Development Framework Core Strategy, and policy DP22 of the London Borough of Camden Local Development Framework Development Policies and are sufficient to discharge condition 7.

You are reminded that conditions 3 (sample panels), 4 (details of SUDS), 6 (details of cycle storage), 9 (evidence of internal water use), 10 (detailed drawings) and 11 (details of chartered basement engineer) of planning permission granted on 07/10/16 (ref: 2015/4396/P) are outstanding and require details to be submitted and approved.
