I understand there is a meeting Thursday 14th re
planning permission for proposed plans on my
building. I have heard nothing from your dept.
direct and neither have other residents / shop-
holders ?? I resent very much being told
all information is "on-line." The arrogance
and naivety of Camden to ^{elderly} residents being
told that over 50yrs of residency and you
collecting enormous Council Tax over this long
period means absolutely nothing !!

I was also told that notices had been put outside on lamp posts. I would thoroughly recheck that statement as no locals have seen them. If you can send staff to put notices up, then it makes much more sense to put them through our letter boxes, if you really want us to see them! I am unable to attend on Thursday but am most concerned about these points:

- 1) Strength of rail tunnel beneath us
- 2) Being on raised pavement, access to pedestrians + shops impossible with scaffolding
- 3) Ground level behind block on different levels - access to cones - major dip/hall
- 4) While scaffolding erected - no possibility of opening windows or having day light in our Home!!
- 5) Major traffic problems due to very heavy Goods vehicles/cranes.
- 6) No parking for residents, shop keepers or their customers.

I await your response with interest.
