The Council has considered your application and decided to **refuse** planning permission for the following reason(s):

Reason(s) for Refusal

1 The proposed first floor rear extension by reason of its location, bulk and mass



would result in harm to the character and appearance of the host building and of this part of the Bloomsbury Conservation Area, contrary to policies D1 (Design) and D2 (Heritage) of Camden Local Plan 2017.

The proposed first floor rear extension, by reason of its location, bulk and mass would result in a loss of amenity to neighbouring occupiers by virtue of the impact on sunlight, daylight and sense of enclosure to the adjoining windows at No. 7 Coptic Street, contrary to policies A1 (Managing the impact of Development) of Camden Local Plan 2017.

In dealing with the application, the Council has sought to work with the applicant in a positive and proactive way in accordance with paragraphs 186 and 187 of the National Planning Policy Framework.
