Dear Mr Bell,

I write in relation to your email of 12 September to my colleague, Nadia Abdullah. Nadia is no longer working at Curl la Tourelle Head and I will be your contact moving forward.

We discussed the following proposal:

The planting in the border will be supplemented with additional evergreen ferns: *polysticum*s so that the whole border is filled.

No beech hedge.

No new tree in that planting area, mitigated by the fact that the school has undertaken significant tree planting this year on another part of the site, as shown on the attached photographs. The head confirms that 150 native trees were planted. You may be able to identify species from the photo, but if you require more detail, I can ask the Head Teacher.

We agreed that it would be possible to deal with this outstanding matter by an exchange of emails rather than the issue of amended drawings, subject to your approval of the proposal. I am very appreciative of that fact.

I would be grateful if you could approve the proposals so that the outstanding condition on the planning approval can be signed off by Charlotte Meynell as soon as possible. I am copying to Ms Meynell for information.
