The poplar we now ask to fell overhangs a garden studio and threatens to come down on it as the trunk is hollow at the top and appears to be hollow all the way to the bottom.


We plan to remove all branches from site and leave large pieces of trunk along the communal garden wall as we did before, to encourage bio diversity and natural life.
