- Prune back all overhang on clients side.
- Crown reduce height by 3m (suitable branch junction) and shape all sides to match.
- (Emphasis on creating more space in garden by removing heavy overhanging branches)

(T2) Bay

- Remove large lowest limb that overhangs clients property.
- Crown reduce height by 3m and shape all sides to match.
- Remove 2x lowest branches from the smaller Bay on LHS.

(T3) Holly

- Remove lowest RHS limb overhanging clients property
