The existing structure has never been given permission and has only been used as a greenhouse for growing plants in and for housing a washing machine. It has therefore never caused overlooking/privacy issues nor light pollution. The effective change of use is not appropriate for these reasons, and a new conservatory in this location on any other house would be refused as being detrimental to the rear elevation of the Listed Building. Replacement will set a bad precedent.</p> <p>The removal of trees is unnecessary and the loss of habitat with replacement by hard landscaping detrimental to wildlife. It appears as if there are other trees in the garden that are not noted in the tree report.</p> <p>The proposal to have a large permanent fire pit and BBQ will cause nuisance to neighbours and result in smoke that is detrimental to health (and surely against the Clean Air act).</p>
