Both of these will have their access to afternoon light massively reduced by a grossly overdeveloped 8metre high wall of brick and tile. This will reduce the quality of living of all the main communal areas of the house, as well as forever destroy the intended quality of setting so carefully orchestrated by the original architect, one of our greatest modernists. This application is clearly a greedy over development that has absolutely no regard for its neighbour, for its setting, and provides nothing of any benefit to the area, in fact redicing the real number of dwellings provided in a time when every unit is sorely needed. I strongly recommend this is rejected.
