I object to the application 2017/4624/P. One has the strong sense that if this application had been inspected by the Planning Committee earlier this year then it would have been refused. And it would have been refused on the grounds of the over-large, over-bearing windows which now comprise the roof extension. This is wholly unsuited to being situated so close to the listed 1 Colville Place and the rest of that historic street. An extension in this style also acts in longer views to disrupt the gentle and quiet setting of Whitfield Street south. This will be read as nothing more than a sheer, glassy protuberance rising above the existing building lines and will be harmful to the area as a whole as well as nearby buildings, as stated.
