Proposal:

Installation of perimeter trellis screens around roof of rear extension, glazed timber skylights on roof and railings on existing access bridge, in association with creation of roof terrace on existing single-storey rear extension (retrospective).

The trellis screens, by virtue of their size, location and detailed design, are considered to be incongruous additions at the rear of the property and have a detrimental impact on the character, setting and special interest of the host building and on the setting of the adjacent listed buildings, contrary to policy D2 (Heritage) of the London Borough of Camden Local Plan 2017.
