Re Flat A, 5 Mornington Terrace, NW1

With apologies for the delay our comments are as follows:

- ∞ Of the 2 proposals for renewing the basement's 2 front windows we have no objection to the proposal that has the fewest panes per window sash, i.e. we think the windows that look simpler are better because they match the simple windows above which we believe are the original pattern.
- ∞ Materials should be timber and glass.
- ∞ To get the thermal and acoustic advantages of double glazing there are double-glazing units available that are approximately 10mm thick that fit within traditionally sized timber sash windows to match the original. Quite a few properties in neighbouring streets in the Conservation Area have benefitted from new (or modified existing) windows with this type of glazing.

We hope this is helpful.
