1 Reason for approval:

The condition requires the submission of details of noise and vibration mitigation for each building across the development site to safeguard the amenity of the future occupiers. The applicant has provided a report outlining the approach that will be



taken to the implementation of the equipment and the proposed mitigation measured together with details of the attenuation, sealing of the extracts and the vibration isolation schedule. The details provided have been reviewed by the Council's Environmental Health officer and considered sufficient for the approval of condition 34.

The site's planning history and relevant appeal decisions were taken into account when coming to this decision.

The details provided are in general accordance with policies CS5 of the London Borough of Camden Local Development Framework Core Strategy and policies DP26 and DP28 of the London Borough of Camden Local Development Framework Development Policies.
