Town and Country Planning Acts 1990 (as amended) Town and Country Planning (Tree Preservation Order) Regulations 1999 **GRANT CONSENT FOR WORKS TO TREE/S UNDER A TREE PRESERVATION ORDER**

Proposal:

(TPO ref: c1098) WITHIN COURTYARD: 1 x Robinia - Remove (and replace with Honey Locust) at a height of 5m, with girth of 20-25cm in the same location).

The Council has considered your application dated 19 September 2017 and decided to grant consent subject to the following condition(s):

Conditions and Reasons:

- 1 This decision is valid for 2 years from the date of this decision or until the work is completed, which ever is the sooner.
 - Reason: To allow the Local planning authority to monitor the completion and standards of the work.
- 2 All work shall be carried out in accordance with the relevant recommendations of British Standard 3998: 2010. (Recommendation for Tree Work)



Reason: To ensure the preservation of the amenity value and health of the tree(s).

During the first available planting season following the completion of works, a Gleditsia tricanthos (honey locust) tree shall be planted in the same location as the application tree as a semi-mature specimen with a girth size of 20-25cms, unless otherwise agreed in writing by the local authority. The tree shall be planted and maintained to the standards set out in BS8545:2014.

Reason: In order to comply with the provisions of Section 206 of the Town and Country Planning Act 1990 (as amended).

Informative(s):

Please note that any approval given by the Council does not give an exemption from the requirements to comply with the Wildlife and Countryside Act 1981 (as amended), or any other Acts offering protection to wildlife.
