Rear Garden:

2 x Apple: Located rear of lawn area. Reduce crowns by 20%, remove dead wood and thin crown density by 15%.

Acer: Remove dead wood and thin crown density by 10-15%.

Elder Sapling. Growing on left hand boundary. Fell and treat with systemic herbicide.

Judas: Remove dead wood, thin crown density by 15% and reduce crown by 15%.

Front Garden:

Magnolia: This is a splendid young tree and was a good planting choice for its location. Some minimal pruning can be carried out in order to help manage size. Tip reduce crown by 15-20%.

Reasons: General maintenance and to maintain trees at their current dimensions.
