2017/5311/P	Lundi Swain	16 St Augustine's Rd	18/10/2017 13:20:40	COMMEM AIL	<p>I wish to object to the retrospective planning permission for items constructed at 13 St Augustine's Road which were not in the original application.</p> <p>1: Ornate fencing in wrought iron at front of property is completely at odds with all other properties in this conservation area which have brickwork.</p> <p>2: Double entrance is at odds with conservation status as all other properties have a single gate (except where there is a driveway).</p> <p>3: Cycle / bin housings at front of property (cycle housing marked 'possible' on original drawing). The additional large housing which extends from the house almost to the street is completely at odds with all other properties in this conservation area, which have been left open. The bulk of this structure interrupts the uncluttered nature of the rest of this street and is an eyesore.</p> <p>In this Conservation area and in the unique Street, St Augustine's Road, almost all properties have retained the original look and feel of the Victorian architecture since the 1850s, some despite extensive alterations. The off plan changes to 13 St Augustine's Road have no architectural merit and are structurally unnecessary. As such, they should not be allowed and the front part of the property and garden should be returned to an open and walled condition.</p>
