Proposed Work:

REAR GARDEN: 1 x Bay - Remove central branch that crosses back to trunk collar, prune back all overhang on clients side, crown reduce height by 3m (suitable branch junction) and shape all sides to match.

1 x Bay - Remove large lowest limb that overhangs clients property, crown reduce height by 3m and shape all sides to match, remove 2x lowest branches from the smaller Bay on LHS

1 x Holly - Remove lowest right hand side limb overhanging client's property

The Council has considered your notification of intended works to trees dated 26 September 2017 and does not wish to object.

- 2 You are advised that the appropriate standards for tree work are set out in BS 3998: 2010. Failure to ensure that the proposed works are carried out to these




standards may result in damage to the tree(s) and may result in legal action by the Council.
