The Council has considered your application and decided to **refuse** planning permission for the following reason(s):

Reason(s) for Refusal

- 1 The proposed recessed shopfront would harmfully detract from the appearance and character of the host building, streetscene, and wider shopping parade contrary to policies A1 (Managing the impact of development), D1 (Design), D3 (Shopfronts) of the Camden Local Plan 2017.
- 2 The proposed recessed shopfront, by reason of its inappropriate design and physical recess would give rise to crime and antisocial behaviour to the detriment of community safety and security, contrary to policies C5, D1 and D3 of the London



Borough of Camden Local Plan 2017.
