(S) Location of signage / interpretation



- 01** Mounded planting to accommodate spoil and surplus material, and facilitate open mosaic habitat in keeping with a brownfield site, to include annual meadow displays as well as pioneer species
- 02** Gabion insect hotels and habitat spaces providing an interactive learning space and reinforcements to stepped landscape
- 03** New entrances gates by local metal worker
- 04** Multi-use space for weddings, conferences, wildlife weekend fayres etc. capable of holding a 12m x 16m marquee for all weather events, permeable bound gravel surface suitable for vehicle loading
- 05** Stepped timber decked area to access canal side, with resurfaced existing steps and enhanced existing border planting
- 06** New step-free, accessible route to the building
- 07** Relocated and clad storage container
- 08** Level access to rear providing outdoor classroom space, pedestrian loading bound gravel surfacing.
- 09** 6 no. category C trees removed to accommodate new building and open up views to the canal
- 10** 1.4m high secure boundary treatment/fence to the natural park with 2 no. pedestrian gates
- 11** Widened access (to 2.5m) to south of the proposed building, gated access
- 12** New bark mulch 1.2m wide footpath with timber edging
- 13** Site for temporary art installations
- 14** Bin store for 2 no. 1100lt Eurobins, 1500mm height
- 15** Extended gabion retaining wall
- 16** Pedestrian 1.1m timber gates to natural park (2 in total)
