I would like to object strongly to the proposals for cutting down and removing trees and bushes in the application 2017/5507/T on the edge of Hampstead Heath and the Vale of Health Ponds - a haven for wildlife in London.

First of all the property described and shown on the drawings is not Spencer House, but next to Spencer House. I believe the applicant has no relation to Spencer House. In addition, the damage caused to any tree by 'machinery' was probably done by the applicant instructing those who operated the 'machinery'. Although I have no proof of this.

These trees and bushes are vital to biodiversity in this sensitive part of Hampstead Heath and London. I urge anybody who has any influence to make sure this natural haven is not further destroyed by the person who has occupied this site and removed without permission a great deal of plant life that the wildlife will have lived on.

I believe the structure that has been built on the site is also illegal and built without planning permission. The site was historically not intended for fixed buildings.
