The increase of traffic, noise, cooking odour and general waste in the vicinity of the proposed kitchens will have a detrimental effect on the everyday life of the local residents.</p> <p>The applicant quoted that "Local planning authorities should work proactively with applicants to secure developments that improve the economic, social and environmental conditions of the area" in the Planning design and access statement. The proposed kitchens will no doubt improve the economic position of Deliveroo but how can noise and air pollution created by the extractor fans, which will affect the residents in the neighbourhood on a daily basis, be an improvement of the social or environmental conditions of the area?
