

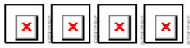

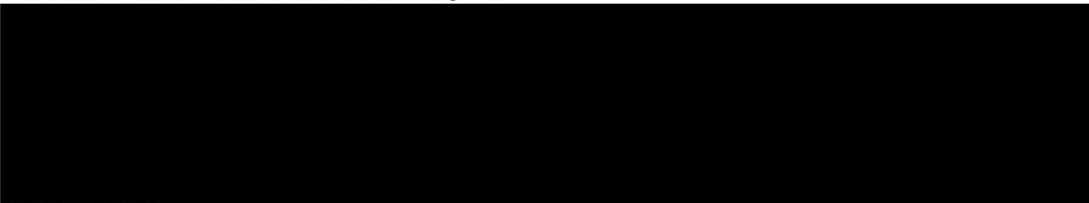

Subject: Concern

While I appreciate the Royal Free Hospital and the good work they do, it is with deep concern that I have read about the Royal Free Hospital's plans to build a new unit on the space of the car park on their site.

Continued and insistent development on an already overdeveloped site can only but impact the lives of the local community. Matters are made worse by the negative impacts this construction will have on Hampstead Hill School, both in terms of potential structural damage to a Grade I St Stephen site, and to the daily lives of the children that are educated there.

It is troubling that submission has been carefully tailored to bypass the Section 106 sanction that construction should pose no threat to the St Stephen site. And may I remind you that the site is filled with young on children on a daily basis.

I am against this construction going ahead.

Surely the unit could be placed elsewhere on their very extensive site!
