We had concerns about the original application but were prepared to go along with it, since there seemed to be some attention to getting the details right. However, this retrospective application should be rejected for a number of reasons including : firstly, the plate glass windows which are shameful on a building such as this, especially since it stands 'proud' of all the other buildings on a prominent corner plot. The applicant must be forced to adhere to the original approved application and install sash windows to match the lower floors. Secondly : the extended height of the chimneys is overkill, and largely a ruse to provide a back wall to what has become an oft-used roof terrace. The applicant must be forced to adhere to the original approved application and reduce the height and mass of the chimneys. Whilst writing, we would draw the Planners attention to the fact that this application makes no mention of the unapproved French windows on the top floor, which give access to the aforementioned roof terrace. We would strongly urge Camden Planners to insist that these doors are removed and replaced with the previously approved sash windows. We are happy to provide the planners with photos of this abuse of the planning system, should you wish to see them.
