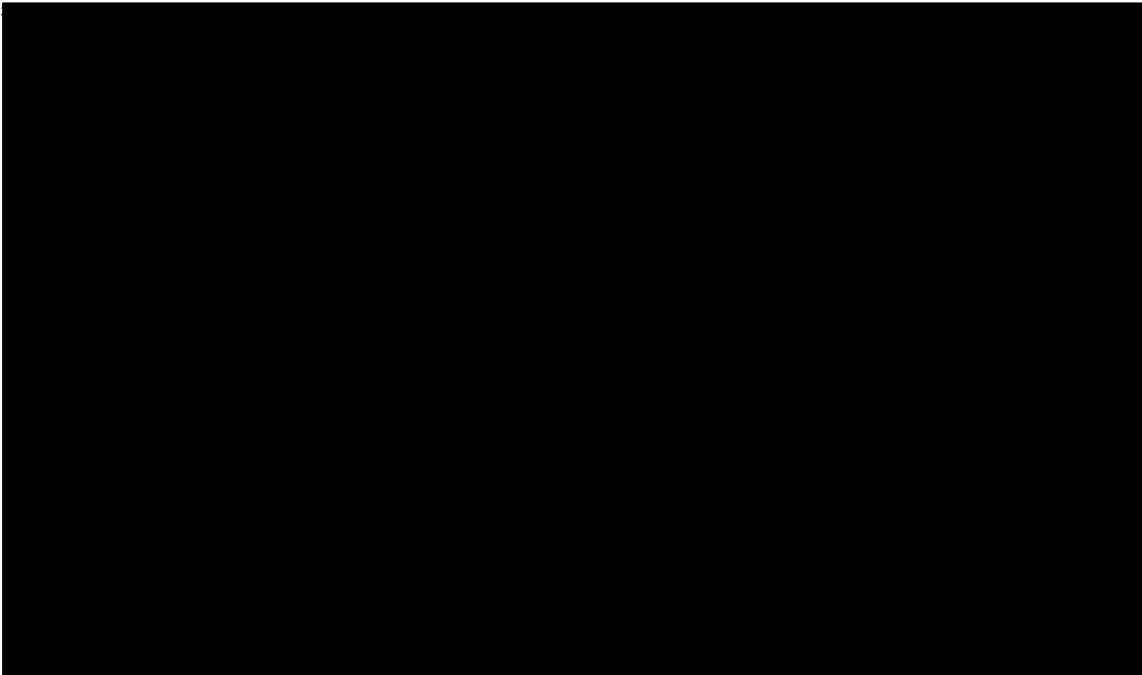

The scheme has to be viewed in conjunction with previous planning consent for 90B Savernake Road and 90A Savernake Road (2007/0481/P &amp; 2015/2000/P.)</p> <p>The land on which 88 Savernake Road is built is at a higher level than that upon which 90 Savernake Road is built . The whole scheme must be viewed in this context . Existing side windows overlook side windows of 90A , a 3rd additional window would further limit privacy of 90A as the window would be directly opposite an existing window in 90A . I am concerned at the fact that the proposed staggered extension to the side of the building would again limit privacy and light for 90A . I am particularly concerned and object to the side elevation which at its widest would, I believe, be less than 122cm from the boundary with 90A.</p> <p>The scheme for the rear extension will reduce light to the garden of 90A. I object to the proposed form massing of a stepped raised height above 2.8m to that of 'approximately' 3.5m for the extension to the rear . The garden of 90A is already overshadowed and boxed in by (Planning Consent ref 2016/1448/P for 90B) by the erection of a heightened elevated fencing which blocks light and a garden shed with an elevated raised roof which has not complied with Planning Consent</p>

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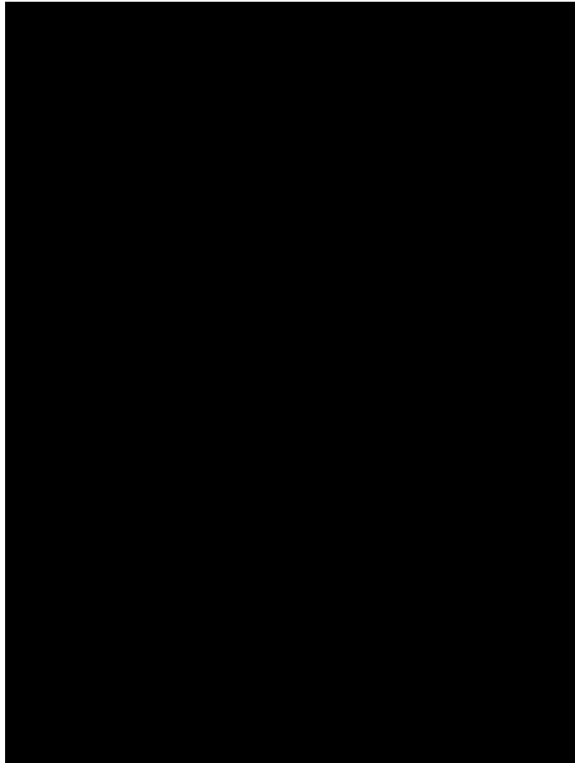
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
