GV II

2 terraced houses. 1766-1770, altered. Partially re-faced following the original

multi-coloured stock brick. Slated mansard roof with dormers. Stucco 1st floor sill and floor bands. Earlier C19 shopfront with projecting shop window with entablature with projecting dentil cornice. Glazing altered. Wooden doorcase with pilasters carrying enriched console-bracketed entablature; round-arched fanlight and panelled door. Gauged red brick flat arches to recessed sashes. Parapet. INTERIOR: open tread stair with moulded, wreathed handrail, turned balusters and column newels. 1st floor front room ceiling moulded with foliated wreaths and central patera. Patterned cornice. No.33: stock brick, coloured red. Slated mansard roof with large dormer. Stone cornice at 3rd floor level. Stucco 1st floor sill and floor bands. 4 storeys (3rd floor later addition). 3 windows. Late C19 stucco shopfront of 4 bays with round-arched openings to match C18 doorway. Wooden doorcase with pilasters carrying enriched consoles (entablature removed). INTERIOR: 1st floor front room with moulded ceiling of rope and floral design. Patterned cornice. SUBSIDIARY FEATURES: attached cast-iron railings with torche flambe finials to areas.

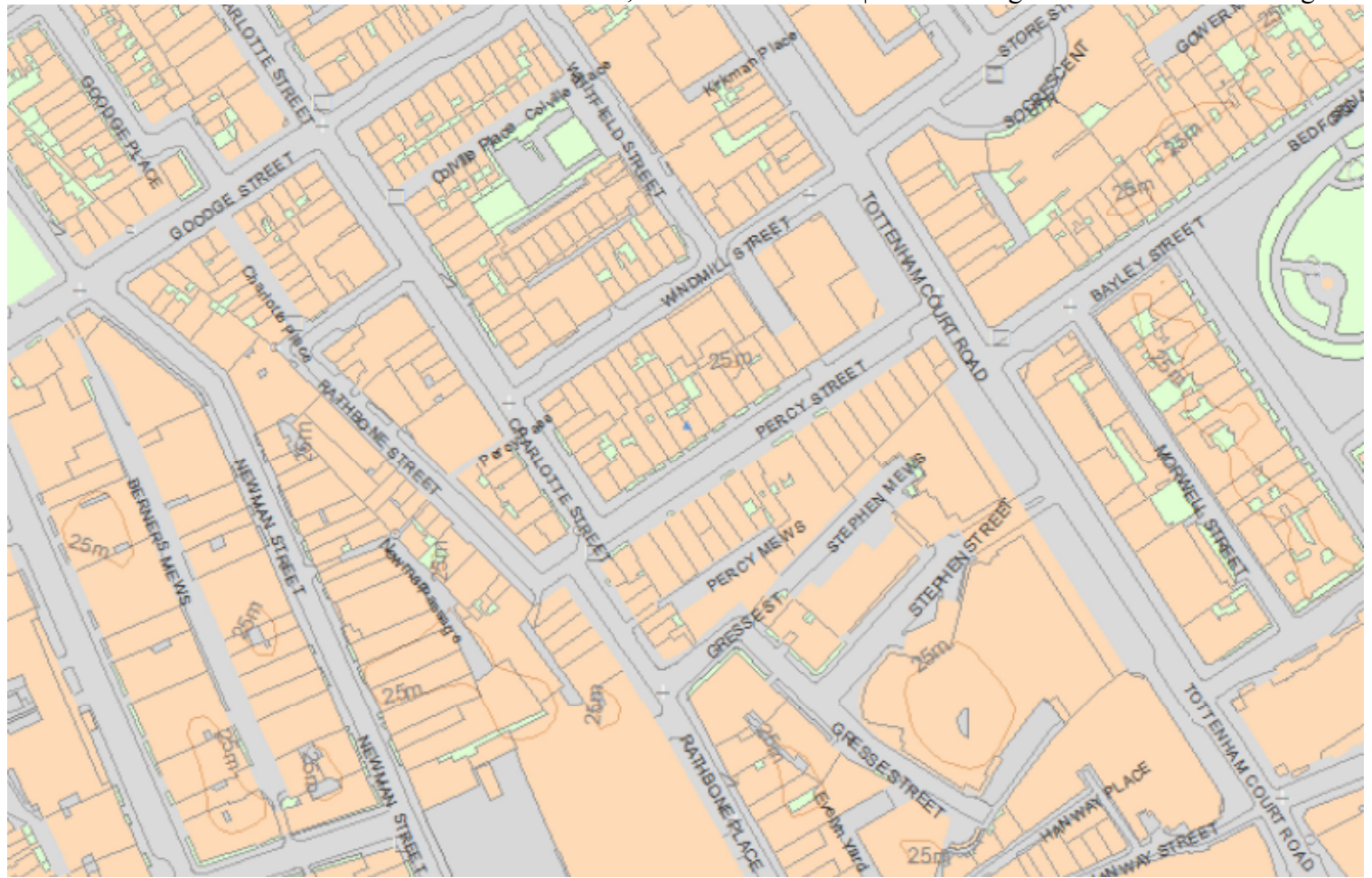
