I am writing to appeal against the above planning being granted. My main objections are that this is a conservation area and we already have very limited road parking. There are no houses with frontage actually on Branch Hill that have off street parking in our section of Branch Hill and any crossovers would reduce the limited parking that there is. Also we only have pavement on one side of the road. The parking space is used by residents of Branch Hill, Savoy Ct, and West Heath Lodge and since the Council put double yellow lines down Heysham Lane there is nowhere else to park as we are at the end of the CA-H zone and Upper Terrace is always full at night. I have difficulty walking and had to park in a different zone and it took me a half hour to get home. But my main concerns are a) the rush hour and road rage that occurs daily and b) the change in character and the danger crossovers will cause to a beautiful and historic conservation area
