We are writing to object to planning application 2017/6045/P.

We live very near the proposed development and object on the following basis:

1. The development contravenes policies on the protection of Open Spaces and destroys a vital green lung in an otherwise built-up area.
2. The development would destroy the habitat of many protected insects and birds, destroy views across the site and create air, noise and light pollution in what was previously a quiet, pleasant and undisturbed space.
3. The design itself is poor, with the buildings of excessive size, bulky in nature and an unnecessary and unwanted over development of the area.
4. Should the development proceed, it would generate unacceptable levels of traffic and parking in an already congested area.

For these reasons, we would strongly object to planning permission being granted for this development. It is wholly inappropriate for the area and I hope that the planning team are able to see this.
