REFUSAL OF CONSENT FOR WORKS TO TREE/S UNDER A TREE PRESERVATION ORDER

(TPO REFS C18A & C518) REAR GARDEN 2 x Limes - Fell

The Council has considered your application dated 16 October 2017 and decided to refuse consent for the following reason(s):

Reason(s) for Refusal

The two lime trees are growing within the rear garden of a residential property that is situated within the South Hampstead Conservation Area. The application has been submitted due to alleged tree root property damage.

The two limes are highly visible from the public realm. Although the trees are situated within the rear garden, two limes trees provide a high level of visual amenity to the public as the property is on the corner of West End Lane and Woodchurch



Road. The trees are located close to boundary with the highway.

The two lime trees have been maintained by reduction and appear to be in fair condition both structurally and physiologically. Both trees are considered to have a significant safe useful life expectancy. The two tree are considered to contribute to the character of this part of the conservation area.

The application alleges that T3 is implicated in tree root property damage. The damage has been classified as cat. 2 (Slight) in accordance with BRE Digest 251, which states that, in relation to this level of damage "Cracks easily filled". No level monitoring data has been submitted.

The application be refused to protect the visual amenity the trees provide and the character of this part of the conservation area.
