



Dear David

I own a property in King Henry's Road (First Floor Flat, 93 King Henry's Road) and I have just been made aware of the proposed planning development directly opposite my property. I am writing to object to the planning application submitted for the buildings directly opposite. The reasons for my objections are as follows:-

- ∞ Loss of light and overshadowing to my property
- ∞ New floors will directly overlook my property, therefore creating a loss of privacy
- ∞ The building work will create a lot of noise disturbance in the area
- ∞ The visual design of the new floors is disagreeable, and I have concerns about the design - I do not like the design or the appearance. It is out of scale and character in terms of appearance
- ∞ I believe that the work done on the properties directly opposite where I currently live will have an impact on my property and create a loss of property value
- ∞ The proposed design is out of character for properties in the area
- ∞ There will be a detrimental effect of the proposed development on the character of the local area
- ∞ There will be a huge impact in the area due to the effects of construction - dust, noise, traffic. This will cause significant disruption
