

Dear Madam/Sir,

We are writing to object against the planning application to build a large-scale Lifecare centre at the Gondar Gardens Reservoir.

We strongly object to the planned construction on the following grounds:

- ∞ Contravenes the policies on protection of Open Spaces in urban areas
- ∞ Excessive height and large-scale construction in a low rise traditional area
- ∞ Excessive noise, traffic, pollution during the construction of this large-scale development
- ∞ Air, noise, light pollution
- ∞ Destrys natural habitats of protected animals
- ∞ No provision of affordable homes

This planned construction has caused significant concern to the local community. This is a quiet area that provides high quality of living. This would be in jeopardy by a large scale disruptive and out of character development. There has already been significant new building development in the area, but these were constructed in areas of high noise and traffic. This particular part of West Hampstead is however very quiet with a lovely community feel. I and other members of your local community strongly hope that you will consider the impact this monstrous and anti-social development would have on the residents.
