The tree is a mature sycamore with a girth of 2.3 metres at the North West corner of our garden. It has been damaged by large amounts of ivy. It extends over the pavement and half the road of Dartmouth Park Avenue. In the recent high winds some quite large branches fell into our garden and we are anxious about possible damage in the future to passers by or locally parked cars. We have consulted a professional who has said that it would be

sensible to reduce the crown of the tree by about a third. This should make it safe while preserving its shape and character.
