Dear Laura,

I have looked at the so called revised plans.

They are pretty extensive, and again make changes to the part of the plan which I feel most strongly about. Namely the size and look of the additional top floor. The fact that there is now an internal bar instead of a Juliet balcony will not prevent it being used except for maintenance as is planned. The refigured windows are not at all in keeping with the rest of the building and impact on the next door listed building. They will overlook neighbouring terraces. We already have trouble with local office terraces being used for parties and late night revelries, let alone smoking areas. Quite frankly I see no reason for this 3rd floor extension to be approved at all. All the other frontages on Colville Place are one story lower.

If you had visited the site you would see that the brickwork under the rendering has been interfered with over the years, so exposing the brickwork, with or without a lime wash will look dreadful.

The fact that this planning application has been going for so many years, should suggest to you that they are pushing at boundaries, which they do not expect to respect.
