• A deciduous multistem tree shrub is proposed in the Outpatients Terrace facing Millman Mews, with approx. height at the time of planting 3m; mature height of approx. 5m; spread min. 1,5-2m.

The proposed species is Cornus kousa var. chinensis. The tree would provide dappled shade and seasonal interest. C. kousa is a small bushy tree, with oval leaves turning reddish-purple in autumn, and tight clusters of small white flowers surrounded by four large oval cream bracts and followed by straweberry-like deep pink fruit clusters.
