					The result of the first floor terrace is that the occupants and their guests now: 1) look straight into my dressing room from the terrace. This causes embarrassment while I am changing. 2) congregate on the terrace and cause noise late into the night, preventing sleep.
					The terrace should never have been built in the first place.
					I therefore wish to make it a condition of agreeing to the improvements to the conservatory that that section of the terrace wall which abuts my property is raised by at least 2 metres, thereby preventing further sight intrusion into my property. The terrace should never have been constructed in the first place, so it is the least I can do to try to regain my privacy.
					I should also explain that my agreeing to the improvements to the conservatory does not imply any agreement to access my property for the purpose of the works. That is something which will need discussion in due course.
