The drawings proved to be inaccurate and although the design and access statement refers to this application as pending, it is no longer on the website.</p> <p>Following complaints from residents, the unapproved hobs and a noisy extractor unit were removed under enforcement proceedings. However, the smells have continued and the lack of air conditioning has resulted in noise from doors being left open at the rear, especially during the summer.</p> <p>This new application seeks approval for extraction equipment to deal with smells and noise. The Swain's Lane R&amp;NW Association supports the need for measures to be taken to remove the disturbance caused to residents in adjoining properties under its existing A1 Retail operations. It agrees with the submission by the HLE CAAC on the need to clarify the inconsistencies in the drawings and notes the comments on the adequacy of whether what is proposed will deal adequately with the problems. Certainly, conditions should be attached to ensure that the objectives of eliminating smells and noise are achieved without causing further disturbance to the residents.</p>

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
