Thanks for consulting TfL on this planning application.

The site of the proposed development is adjacent to Euston Road A501, which forms part of the Transport for London Network (TLRN). TfL is the highway authority for the TLRN, and is therefore concerned about any proposal which may affect the performance and/or safety of the TLRN. Therefore, no skips or construction material shall be kept on the footway or carriageway of the TLRN at any time.

The proposed advertisement should follow the illumination guidelines below to avoid driver distraction and ensure the safety of bus passengers, pedestrians and cyclists.

The proposed advertising should operate at appropriate illumination levels for day and night time, consistent with the guidance set out in the Institute of Lighting Professionals (ILP) publication: "The Brightness of Illuminated Advertisements" (PLG05, January 2015). This should be secured by condition.

There shall be no special effects (including noise, smell, smoke, animation, exposed cold cathode tubing, flashing, scrolling, three dimensional, intermittent or video elements) of any kind during the time that any message is displayed. This should be secured by condition.

Subject to the above conditions being met, TfL has no objections to the proposal.
