NO OBJECTION TO SECTION 211 NOTICE OF WORKS TO TREE/S IN A CONSERVATION AREA

Proposed Work:

FRONT GARDEN: 1 x Holly - Reduce height by 1.5m, trim sides and shape the crown to conical.

1 x Viburnum - Reduce the top by .5m, get a bit more clearance from the house. Shape the low section near the path.

REAR GARDEN: 1 x Cherry - Reduce crown by up to 2m, back to previous cuts. Remove any rubbing branches and dead wood.

1 x Cherry - Reduce crown by up to 1m. Reduce the branch over the house to the height of the gutter. Reduce long branch over the neighbour's garden to uprights 1.5m from tips.

The Council has considered your notification of intended works to trees dated 11 November 2017 and does not wish to object.


- 1 This notice is valid for 2 years from the date of this letter or until the work is completed, whichever is the sooner.
