1 Reasons for granting approval:

The proposed juliet balconies to the rear elevation and projecting balconies on the rear elevation would have laminated glass and stainless steel tops with the bottom rails fixed with masonry. Their design and materials are considered acceptable and appropriate for this contemporary designed building.



The full impact of the proposed development has already been assessed. The proposed details would not have a harmful impact on the appearance of the host buildings and streetscene or on the character of the conservation area. Special attention has been paid to the desirability of preserving or enhancing the character or appearance of the conservation area, under and s.72 of The Planning (Listed Buildings and Conservation Areas) Act 1990 as amended by the Enterprise and Regulatory Reform Act 2013.

The proposed development is in general accordance with policies D1 and D2 of the Camden Local Plan 2017.
