The Home Office-led emergency services mobile communications programme provides a basis to develop a new 'blue-light' communications service known as the Emergency Services Network (ESN).

EE Limited have been selected by the Home Office to provide the resilient national mobile network and appointed a number of agents including WHP Telecoms (WHP) to support site identification, acquisition and planning approval services to extend critical site coverage across the UK.
