1 Reasons for granting.

It is considered that the proposed siting and orientation of the solar panels are



acceptable. They are located flush to the rear roof which is at an angle of 22 degrees south-west facing. By virtue at the rear, it would have minimal wider viewpoints to the public. They are also far less prominent than the approved panels on the parent application, which were on the ridge.

No objections have been received and the planning history of the site has been taken into account when coming to this decision.

As such, the proposed details are in general accordance with former policies CS5 and CS13 of the London Borough of Camden Local Development Framework Core Strategy, policy DP24 of the London Borough of Camden Local Development Framework Development Policies.
