We oppose this application, on these grounds:

- 1. The basement and ground floor extensions would occupy 100% of the site area, leaving no open space for garden or green area. This amounts to gross overdevelopment.
- 2. The drawings are unclear and incomplete, in particular showing no contextual relationship with neighbouring houses. Such architectural information that is shown is minimal, of poor quality, and indicating a lack of interest in the character of the house or its neighbours in our Conservation Area.
- 3. The section drawings are ludicrously inaccurate, and indicate nothing of the proposed structure of the proposals; especially the thickness, dampproofing or detail of the basement walls.
- 4. No BIA is presented. Although the extension at this level is small, it could have structural implications on adjoining houses.

A most unsatisfactory proposal; please refuse.
