The suggested works are: To remove the two pieces of deadwood. Rear left T3 London Plane x 1 (Platanus x hispanica) Very large, mature, previously reduced tree. The tree overhangs the garages and the neighbouring school playground. The work will have to be carried out over the Christmas holiday period to avoid any disruption to the school. To contain spread and to reduce the moisture uptake, the suggested works are: To reduce the overall height and the lateral spread all round by 3 - 4m back to the most recent points of reduction, retain shortened furnishing growth (where possible) for crown continuity, remove deadwood. Rear, neighbours T4 Ash x 4 (Fraxinus excelsior) Early mature to mature trees. The trees belong to the school and they have reduced the lateral spread that affects the playground but haven't touched the opposite side. To maintain balanced crowns and to reduce the extent of the overhang, the suggested works are: To reduce the overhanging lateral spread back by 2 - 2.5m. 8.
