T2-Sycamore tree- Cut back right hand section above large cavity to approximately 0.5 metres above cavity, reduce left section to approximately two metres from main trunk.

T3- Maple tree- Reduce two branches over garden by approximately three metres, reduce lvy on two branches by approximately two metre.

T4- Lime tree- Remove hanging branches, dead branches and cut back to create two metres clearance from house, create two metres clearance from Cherry tree.
