Having reviewed the proposed plans for the development behind our garden, I am truly alarmed by these proposals and wish to register my objection. The planned construction would have a very detrimental impact to us as it would 'loom' over our garden and house, blocking out sunlight and sky from the rooms on the garden side of our property, being a mere few meters from them. The proposal is truly made with disregard for us as immediate neighbours as clearly it will be very oppressive. As well as losing daylight inside the house, our garden would also suffer from considerable loss of direct sunlight, with a knock on effect on all the wildlife currently visiting to feed on flowering plants. We bought the house because of the south-facing sunny garden; as you might imagine, the prospect of being left with shadier 'yard' overlooked by this development is quite upsetting.

I trust and hope you will take my objection into consideration in deciding the fate of the proposal.
