- T12 Sycamore To crown raise to 4 metres
- T13 Silver Birch To crown raise to 4 metres
- T14 Sycamore To fell and ecoplug the stump
- T15 Silver Birch To prune to achieve a 2 metre clearance from building.
- T16 Sycamore To crown reduce by 20%
- T17 Sycamore To prune to achieve a 2 metre clearance from the buildings
- T18 Ash To fell as low to ground level as possible
- T19 False Acacia To prune to clear lamp column by 2 metres and crown raise to 4 metres.
- T20 Hornbeam To prune to achieve a 2 metre clearance from building and crown raise to 4 metres
- T21 Sycamore To crown reduce, crown thin and crown raise to 3.5 metres
- T22 Sycamore To crown reduce, crown thin and crown raise to 3.5 metres
- T23 Paulownia to fell and ecoplug the stump.
- T24 Sycamore To fell and ecoplug the stump.
- G1 2 x Whitebeams To Crown raise to 3.5 metres
- G2 5 x Sycamores To crown raise to 4 metres and crown clean all 5 trees.
- G3 8 x Whitebeams To crown raise to 3.5 metres and prune to clear building by 1.5 metres, on all 8 trees.
- G4 Various Species To prune to clear buildings, crown raise and crown clean.
